APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

TREASURER REPORT:

Burt Tunzi and Chet Britz are finishing a better system for tracking, recording and reporting the Treasury data and should be able to have it completed this month. Burt distributed a report handout of income and expenses showing the current balance. Bob Robertson made a motion to approve the report, Tom

Malley seconded and it was approved.

VICE COMMODORE'S REPORT:

Bob Robinson mentioned the Frostbite Race approaching in March. He also talked about boat maintenance and scheduling for better service and not inundating the boat works with a ton of work at the same time.

MEMBERSHIP CHAIR REPORT:

We will be communicating with Michael Green to find out if he will be able to handle this position after being employed. Chet would be willing to take the position with a few changes. Chet said that we have 22 renewed and we need to remind members again so we can complete the roster and make necessary changes.

MEDIA UPDATE:

[Committee Boat repairs and maintenance](#) - Purchasing the new anchors can be done at any time in the near future and Brad will handle that ball. The top deck has been painted again but will be in need of more maintenance.

[K-Cup Punch List](#): Chet has talked with the Riviera, guaranteed 40 people and he and Burt will put in a deposit to fully secure the venue for the breakfast and awards presentations. They will also check on the menus available and reserve one as well. TJ is taking care of the awards and gifts. Bob said we will have the same divisions as last year. Bob will continue with getting the apparel lined up and completed. There was a discussion about different club shirts from the K-Cup shirts being available for members and others interested.

Crab Feed - It will be at 5:00 on Saturday February 2, 2019 at the Buckingham Homeowners Clubhouse. TJ Mickel, John Diederich and Tom Malley are the committee to plan and coordinate the event. Brad has the ABC form filled out and talked about submitting it with a money order or cahiers check. These are the only forms of payment accepted by the ABC. The checklist was used to go through who is doing what. Tom, Arlene and Bob will handle the menu which will consist of oysters, crab, (vegetarian lasagna), salad, bread & butter, apple pie and ice cream. Brad will send out a sign-up reminder with the membership reminder he sends out. John, Tom and Susan will pull out, clean and organize decorations and all of the things involved with the crab feed from storage. We are also trying to contact the advisor for the Kelseyville High School Interact Club to help serve.

Race Docs (Jan) - Brad mentioned updating

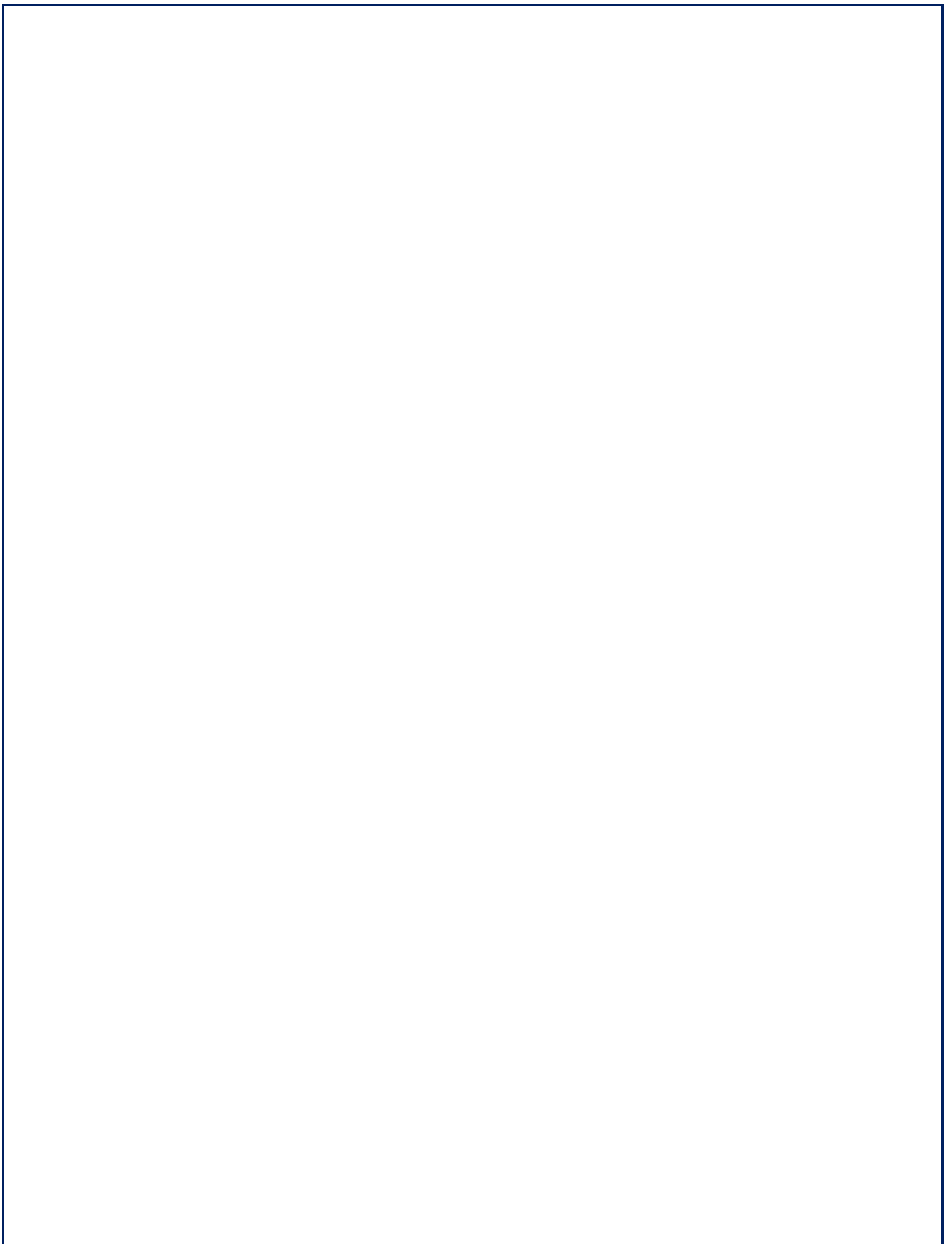
Calendar - We need to work on and finish our calendar for publishing this month. Brad, Bob and Val will work on this.
